## Character Lesson Nine

### *MEEK*

#### **Definition:**

A meek person is gentle, unresisting, willing to bear opposition, and does not fight for his own way.

#### **Examples and/or Questions to Ask the Children:**

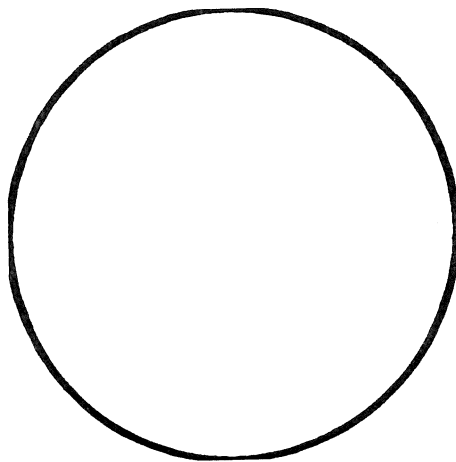
1. The Lord Jesus was betrayed by Judas, but He did not react to Judas when he brought a great crowd with swords and clubs, but rather, the Lord handed Himself over to them. He meekly gave in to them.
2. When you are playing a game and others insist to play a certain way, you go along with them even though you think your way is better.

#### **Verse:**

*"Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth."* Matthew 5:5

#### **Craft Ideas:**

1. Have the children make a sign for a door-knob out of poster board.
2. Draw a large lamb and glue cotton for its wool.
3. Put eyes and nose with black marker or black paper.
4. Cut the hole for the door-knob.
5. The children can draw several "z's" to show that the lamb is sleeping and add to it as they wish with further details. See the attached page for pattern.
